



#### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

and

# The University of Darussalam Gontor, Indonesia

The University of Malaga, Spain (hereinafter UMA), a public educational institution represented by Mr. Juan Teodomiro López Navarrete as Rector of the University of Malaga, with its registered office at Avda. Cervantes, No. 2, 29071 Malaga, acting on behalf and representing the aforementioned institution, pursuant to the appointment granted by decree 298/2023, dated December 27 (published in the BOJA number 5 on 08/01/2024)..;

### AND

The University of Darussalam Gontor, Indonesia, hereafter referred to as UNIDA Gontor institution duly constituted. It has its registered address at, Jl. Raya Siman, Dusun I, Demangan, Kec. Siman, Kabupaten Ponorogo, Jawa Timur. It is represented by Mr. Hamid Fahmy Zarkasyi as the rector of the University of Darussalam Gontor.

The Universidad de Málaga and University of Darussalam Gontor, recognising the benefits to their respective universities from the establishment of international links, conclude this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter: "MoU").

- The purpose of this MoU is to develop academic and educational co-operation and to promote mutual understanding between the two parties.
- 2. Each party agrees to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity.





- 2.1) Exchange of academic, researchers and administrative staff
- 2.2) Exchange of degree and postgraduate students
- 2.3) Conducting collaborative research projects and training activities
- 2.4) Joint supervision of doctoral theses
- 2.5) Establishment of joint curricula
- 2.6) Exchange of publications, academic materials and other information
- 2.7) Joint projects of cultural nature, organization of international conferences, workshops and seminars
- 2.8) Promoting any other co-operation of mutual interest.
- 3. The development and implementation of specific activities based on this MoU will be separately negotiated and agreed between the parties and will be subject to a separate written agreement. Each party agrees to carry out these activities in accordance with the laws and regulations of the respective countries after full consultation and approval.
- 4. It is understood that the implementation of any of the types of co-operation stated in Clause 2 shall depend upon the availability of resources and financial support of the Parties concerned.
- Both parties agree that prior written approval is required before using the other party's name, logo, or other Intellectual Property rights in any advertising or associated publicity.
- Should the collaborative research activities under this MoU result in any potential for intellectual property, each party shall seek an equitable and fair agreement as to ownership and other property interests that may arise.
- This MoU may only be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of each party.
- This MoU shall be effective from the date of signature for an initial period of four years.
  Thereafter, it will be extended for a maximum period of four years if expressed





by both parties before the initial validity period ends. Any party can terminate de MoU with a six-month advance notice.

And in proof of compliance, the parties subscribe the present cooperation agreement in two (2) copies with the same content, leaving one of them held by each of the parties.
