Part One Objectives

1. To collaborate on educational matters for the betterment of the two institutions.
2. To arrange long-run strategy for human resources development.

Part Two Activities

The two institutions agree to collaborate on the following activities.

1. Organizing conferences, seminars, and scientific discussions on various fields.
2. Developing curriculum on Islamic studies, Sharia, Arabic language, Technology, and Islamic heritage and bringing the social and human sciences into Islamic perspectives.
3. Holding joint-research and collaboration on publishing research journals, and secure funding from agreed sponsors.
4. Holding academic meetings of teachers and academic staff between the two universities to discuss academic and scientific issues.
5. Exchanging bulletins and booklets, views and research findings on some important issues in the Muslim world.
6. Holding joint cultural programs of the students.
7. Both Parties agree to provide admission, financial assistance and facilities of research to scholars in their respective countries.
8. Exchanging information on literary sources and library facilities.
9. Exchanging visiting professors between the two institutions for agreed periods.

Part 3 The Implementation

1. The implementations of this agreement will be arranged further by the two parties.
2. The agreement is subject to change and ratification periodically to improve the collaboration.

The two parties agree to finance the activities of this agreement during their implementation.
